

Required Tools

- Cordless Impact Driver (Recommended to have 2 or 3 Batteries)
- Cordless Drill
 - #2,#3 Phillip Bits (Impact rated if possible)
 - #2 square bit (is used eventually on promotional grill)
 - Magnetic bit holder 3" ,4 " and 6" in length
- Sockets (Recommended socket set with these sizes)
 - 6mm,8mm,1/4",5/16",3/8",7/16",1/2",9/16",5/8",11/16",3/4"
 - 10mm and 1/2" must be DEEP SOCKETS (1/2"used 99.9%)
 - 1/4" and 3/8" socket adapters
- Magnetic 7/16 nut driver (Mainly used on Weber Grills)
- Wrenches
 - 10mm, 5/16",7/16",1/2",9/16",3/4" or adjustable wrench
 - Ratchet Wrenches are very helpful.
- 5/32, 3/16" Standard Hex Bit sockets or tips. (Mainly used for Patio Furniture assembly) 4mm allen bit also
- Rubber Mallet
- Box Cutter / Utility Knife (Retractable Stanley is most dependable and safest)

Optional tools

- Flat head and Phillip Screwdrivers or 4 in 1
- Bit magnetizers
- 10mm nut driver
- Wing nut socket - Becomes useful for picnic tables and smoker handles
- 6" extension adapter
- Hammer
- Tin Snips (for metal bandings, i break them with my hammers claw)
- Flex Joint Socket extension 1/4" and 3/8"
- Channel Lock Wrench , Needle nose pliers, mini pry bar , Ratchet
- Cordless Sawzall with wood blade. (not used often but saves a lot of time uncrating riding mowers and UTV's)
